This is a great podcast for a short commute. Chris loves tiny living, investing, debt-free stories, and quick answers to common financial questions.

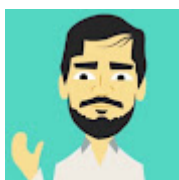

DOCUMENTARIES & FILMS



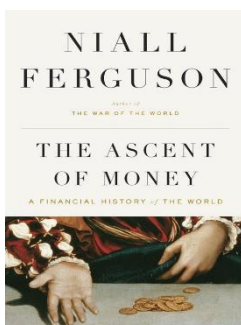
[INSIDE JOB](#)

Inside Job is a documentary on the 2008 economic crisis, on the consequences and corruption of the financial markets. It won the best documentary award at the 2011 Oscars and has become an unparalleled journalistic investigation. A series of interviews with the big names in world finance manages both to perfectly explain what happened, and to demonstrate that the guilty have not been punished and that the errors have not been repaired, starting over just like in the past. This is a surgical film, which deserves to be seen by anyone.



[THE CORPORATION](#)

The documentary entitled The Corporation (2003) introduces the viewer to the different aspects of this institution. The documentary is based on the book written by Joel Bakan entitled "The Corporation: The Pathological Pursuit of Profit and Power". As the title of the book suggests, business companies are too often guilty of pursuing profits trampling on people's interests and the environment. This thesis is adequately demonstrated in the documentary through a collection of interviews, videos and case studies from the past. The documentary is divided into three one-hour episodes and manages to show the viewer the various negative aspects of a business company, which often receives little attention from the mainstream media and civil society.



[THE ASCENT OF MONEY: THE FINANCIAL HISTORY OF THE WORLD](#)

Niall Ferguson in 2008 published a book called "The Ascent of Money: A Financial History of the World". Following the book, a television documentary was made and transmitted under the title of "The Ascent of Money", it explains and analyzes the long history of money, credit and banks.

In 2009 this documentary won an International Emmy Award.

There are 2 versions of this documentary.

The original produced for Channel 4 in the UK consists of 6 episodes.

A more recent and reorganized version was broadcast by PBS with the full original title "The Ascent of Money: The Financial History of the World".
